The Miami-Dade Health Insurance
Assistance program

We can make insurance more affordable for you.

Miami-Dade County is offering a program that can help pay a portion of your monthly health insurance premium for a Miami-Dade Blue¹ health plan from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida (BCBSF).

Miami-Dade Blue Benefits

Along with affordable premiums, Miami-Dade Blue exclusively features a community-focused network of quality providers to help you save on services such as:

- Routine care, including visits to a family physician or specialist and adult routine physicals and well child visits
- Prescription drugs
- Lab tests
- Routine dental care such as cleanings, fillings, x-rays and more
- Hospital stays and surgeries
- Visits to urgent care centers and clinics
- Mammograms

Plus, you can take advantage of special personalized health and wellness support online, over the phone and in person

The amount of assistance you receive from the Miami-Dade Health Insurance Assistance program is based on your annual household income and total amount of your monthly premium for a Miami-Dade Blue¹ health insurance plan.



How do I qualify for the County's Health Insurance Assistance program?

You must be:

- 19-64 years old
- A Miami-Dade County resident
- A single person with an annual income between \$10,830 and \$32,490*
*Higher incomes may apply for families of two or more
- A US Citizen or Qualifying Non-Citizen
- Ineligible for Medicaid, Medicare, or any other public funding
- In agreement to receive your medical care at one of six participating partner sites throughout Miami-Dade County
- Approved for a Miami-Dade Blue health plan, the insurance product partnered with the County's Health Insurance Assistance program

Enrollment in the program is limited to the availability of funds.

If I seem to qualify, how do I apply for our program?

Visit one of six primary care partner sites and simply fill out an application. A list of enrollment sites can be found on the back of the brochure.



The examples below give you an idea of how much you might pay monthly based on total annual household income.

What do I need to bring with me when applying?

- Government issued Photo ID
- Proof of Household Income
- Proof of Miami-Dade County Residency

What's next, if I qualify for the Health Insurance Assistance program?

1. You will be introduced to a Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida licensed agent who will help you complete an application for the Miami-Dade Blue health insurance plan.
2. An initial \$30 premium deposit is due when you fill out the insurance application with your BCBSF agent. This deposit is 100% refundable if you don't qualify for the Miami-Dade Blue health plan.
3. If approved for the Miami-Dade Blue health plan, the Health Insurance Assistance program will begin paying part of your monthly premium (you will receive a coupon book with monthly amount due).
