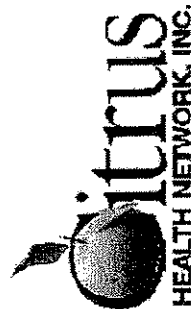


## Citrus Health Network, Inc.

#### MY VOICE AND HOUSING ACT

Housing First type programs for persons who were chronically homeless. Provides rent subsidies to live in community apartments with services brought to the participants through team approach.
