



Meeting Report

October 12th, 2010

The Miami-Dade HIV/AIDS Partnership met on October 12th, 2010 and heard updates on Ryan White Part A, Part B, General Revenue, and the AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP). The next meeting is Monday, November 8th, 2010.

The Board received and approved committee reports, including the following:

From the Care and Treatment Committee:

1. Approved the removal for non-utilization of all of the following : Boost Liquid, Ceclor, Foscavir, Gris-Peg, Isopto Homatropine, Morphine (generic) Immediate Release, Norpramin, Quinaglute, Relenza, Trimethoprim, Trimetrexate, Sporonox 100 mg Capsules and Resource Just for Kids and all nitroglycerin products (Nitro-Bid ointment, Nitro-Dur patch, Nitrolingual Pump).
2. Kept the ACE Aerosol Cloud Enhancer Inhaler Spacer and Nitro-stat or Nitrotab sublingual tablets.
3. Added a notation to the Formulary that only generics should be used for the following medications: Depo-Testosterone, Delatestryl, Effexor, Megace Suspension, Neurontin, Paxil, Prilosec, Remeron, Valtrex, Wellbutrin and Zoloft.
4. Removed Cytovene (Ganciclovir Oral) from the Formulary since it is not used and an alternate medication is available.
5. Removed Floxin, Hydreia and Flonase from the Formulary.
6. Remove Beconase AQ from the Formulary and replace it with Nasarel (generic) as a cost savings and for patient safety issues
7. Approved MAI allocations for inclusion in the Part A grant as follows:
