

**RESEARCH PRESENTATION REQUEST

RESEARCH AD HOC COMMITTEE**

The Miami Dade HIV/AIDS Partnership, the planning body for all HIV/AIDS services in Miami Dade County, has created a Research Ad Hoc Committee to facilitate opportunities to educate the community about research. Through this committee, researchers will have the opportunity to present their findings as well as to discuss new and ongoing research opportunities with the Partnership and its committees, whose members include leaders and representatives from the Ryan White Program; those living with HIV or AIDS; health care organizations; and various community or county agencies, including housing, mental health, substance abuse, social services, medical case management, and others.

The committee is offering opportunities for researchers to present their studies at Partnership, standing committee and sub committee meetings, and Ryan White Program service provider forums, as appropriate. Meeting dates and venues are publicly noticed and available on the Partnership's website, www.aidsnet.org.

Research Ad Hoc Committee

The Ad Hoc Committee is comprised of representatives from the Partnership's Strategic Planning Committee. Membership is also open to the university communities, the Miami Dade County Health Department, community agencies, primary care centers and others who conduct research activities in the field of HIV/AIDS, and who meet the Partnership's eligibility requirements. The committee's goals are to:

- Assist researchers in understanding Miami's diverse community and the unique needs of People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHAs) to aid in developing new research or clinical trials;
- Facilitate linkages between researchers and individual organizations, clinics, PLWHAs, and other community representatives to disseminate information about the availability of current research or clinical trial opportunities in Miami Dade County;
- Integrate research findings into HIV/AIDS community planning and priority setting activities; and
- Provide opportunities for researchers to share results of scientific findings or HIV intervention strategies with the community.
